1. **July 2016 – June 2017 - INCA** - A multi-centre randomised phase II clinical trial of Inotuzumab Ozogamicin plus Rituximab and CVP (IORCVP) versus Gemcitabine plus Rituximab and CVP (GemRCVP) for the first line treatment of patients with diffuse large B cell lymphoma who are not suitable for anthracycline containing chemotherapy.
